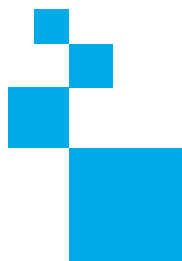


## EMPLOI-QUÉBEC



Are you **under 18** and at least **20 weeks pregnant**?  
Are you without financial resources? Do you know about  
the **Pregnant Minor Financial Assistance Program**?

You could be eligible for monthly financial assistance from the Ministère de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale during the pregnancy up until the birth of your child.

### ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, you must meet certain conditions, including the following:

- participate in the Soutien aux jeunes parents program, administered by the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux;
- not be living with your parents or with someone who has custody of you under a court judgment or sponsorship agreement;
- not be living in accommodation covered by the *Act respecting health services and social services* such as a rehabilitation centre or family-type resource (foster families and foster homes);
- be referred to Emploi-Québec by a CLSC.

### TO APPLY

To apply, go to your local employment centre (CLE). You must bring your CLSC follow-up sheet (fiche de suivi), available from your CLSC caseworker.

### NOTE

The amount of financial assistance provided depends on your circumstances (for example, whether you live in accommodation managed by a non-profit organization that also provides your meals). The assistance may also be reduced if you receive income during the pregnancy.
